Since 2007 we have raised nearly a million dollars for local nonprofit groups and saved millions of books from landfills.

As a for-profit book reuse company and professional fundraiser, we're dedicated to finding good homes for your donated books, CDs, DVDs, audio books, and records. Every book donation we receive is hand sorted at our warehouse to find its best possible purpose. Books are sent overseas through our Books for Troops program, donated to local teachers and schools through our Books for Teachers program, donated to local groups in need through our Get Books program, or sold online and at our Used Book Superstores where every book is discounted dramatically below its original price. We keep books out of the trash, as well as ensure that books will be used in the best way possible.
